	Social media and website: Use the hashtag <u>#FathersEve</u> whenever you can. Promote to public starts the Wednesday after Mother's Day and direct people to the website, www.fatherseve.com.
	The Toast: Join every city hosting a Fathers Eve event around the world for an 8PM toast, "To the dads". It's a signature to this event, get and share the photos.
